Love can be exposed again as a complete art object in its own right. A renting fee of 10% of the initial artist fee has to be paid to the curator/gallerist every time it is being exhibited.

Love bumps into several paradoxes and misunderstandings. It is why it can be remade or copied by someone else despite its copyright protection assured by the newspaper and the stamp of the post.

Love can be lost, or damaged and thus failed.

Love is only valid with this note that has to be signed by the artist and the curator.

Love is an idea.
